Make no mistake... I am the Judge here!

\*\*Natural Horsemanship Class to be judged on the level of horsemanship and partnership exhibited by the horse/rider team as they execute the course. A person has a limited amount of time (30 seconds) to complete an obstacle after the horse's first refusal. Scoring is: horse based off of willingness and cooperation with rider, gait (walk, trot, canter, gallop, bridleless, etc.), etc.; rider is based off of horsemanship, savvy, patience, communication, etc. Rider may be disqualified for excessive force. Courses may be different at each play day.

\* If you enter this class, you will draw a horse from the ones entered in the class and ride that horse. English or western accepted. If you draw an English tacked horse, ride English, etc.

High point award Hoodies will be given to the *Junior & Senior Over-all High-Point Grand Champion & High-Point Reserve Grand Champion* for the play day series.
